## Tuesday, March 3, 2020

Voter Registration Deadline: Feb. 3**

### **This is a Primary Election.**

Voter must declare Republican or Democratic when appearing to vote or when requesting a ballot.

**Presidential Preference Nominees – 4-year term**

**Assessor of Property primary – 4-year term**

**Delegates to 2020 Republican National Convention  
(Republican ballot only)**

## Thursday, August 6, 2020

**Federal & State Primary (Republican and Democratic)  
County General Election**

**Early Voting: Jul. 17 – Aug. 1  
Absentee Ballot Request Period: May 8 – Jul. 30  
Voter Registration Deadline: Jul. 7**

### **There is a Primary Election on August 6.**

Voter must declare Republican or Democratic when appearing to vote or when requesting a ballot if the voter wishes to vote in the Federal & State Primary. Each voter will receive the same County General Election Ballot specific to his/her county district regardless of whether the voter chooses to vote a Party Primary ballot.

**U.S. Senate primary – 6-year term**

**U.S. House 1st Congressional Dis. primary – 2-year term**

**State House 11th House Dis. primary – 2-year term**

**\*Assessor of Property general – 4-year term**

**School Board Member, County Districts 3, 5, and 7 –  
4-year term**

**Constable, County District 1 – 2-year unexpired term**

**Any State Judicial Retention Questions**

## Tuesday, November 3, 2020

**Presidential Election  
Federal & State General Election  
Newport Municipal Election (3 school board positions)**

**Early Voting: Oct. 14 – Oct. 29  
Absentee Ballot Request Period: Aug. 5 – Oct. 27  
Voter Registration Deadline: Oct. 5**

### **This is a General Election.**

Voter does not declare a party preference.

## On the Ballot, November 3, 2020 -

**Electors for U.S. President and Vice President –  
President and Vice President, 4-year term**

**\*U.S. Senate general – 6-year term**

**\*U.S. House 1st Congressional Dis. general – 2-year term**

**\*State House 11th House Dis. general – 2-year term**

**Newport City School Board Member, Citywide –  
4-year term, Vote For Three (3)**

*\* - indicates an office that appears in a primary in the previous election*
